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**Note:** Prior contact with Arabic is not expected for the STARTALK Arabic Academy, which is designed for beginners. For our program, you'll need to be available on Zoom for our small-group classes and shared activities for 4 weeks, June 21–July 16, Monday through Friday (except for the holiday on July 4), from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m., with breaks along the way; you'll also need to spend about another 2 hours in the afternoon or evening on those days, learning on your own time with materials we'll provide (such as videos), or meeting with flexible timing with other members of our program, such as tutors or conversation partners. On Fridays, these 2 additional hours can extend into the weekend if you'd like. If you anticipate having any problem with your availability on this schedule, or any problem with having regular access to Zoom on a laptop, desktop, Chromebook, or other device, please let us know below, as we may be able to work with you to resolve it. For instance, if you anticipate needing to miss a morning or two for another commitment, we might be able to record the class session for you to watch later in the day. [If you don't anticipate any problems with the schedule or Zoom access, just leave this section blank.]

3. a personal statement (two to three paragraphs) describing your interest in studying Arabic at the STARTALK Arabic Academy (Send the statement as a separate file. Include your name and "STARTALK Application: Personal Statement" at the top of the document.)

Applications received by May 15 will be given full consideration, though later applications may also be considered if space remains.
